Long-time Prineville Police Sergeant Retires

Prineville, Oregon

The Prineville Police Department announces the retirement of Police Sergeant Glenn David (Dave) Calhoun. Dave Calhoun began his law enforcement career with the U.S. Army in 1974 as a Military Police Officer. In 1980, Dave Calhoun left the Army and went to work for the Union County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy, where he worked for a year before becoming a Police Officer in Elgin, Oregon in 1981. In 1984 Dave Calhoun moved to Prineville where he settled with his wife and two sons after being hired by the Prineville Police Department as a Police Officer. In 1986, Officer Calhoun was promoted to Detective, becoming the first Narcotics Detective for the City of Prineville Police. A post he held until 1993, when Det. Calhoun was promoted to Sergeant. On April 28th, 1995 Sgt. Calhoun distinguished himself by being awarded the Oregon Peace Officers Association "Medal of Valor", after responding to a call of a suicidal person, he was able to talk a woman, who was pregnant with twins, into dropping a knife and not killing herself. Sgt. Calhoun has a long and distinguished career serving the citizens of Prineville and will be greatly missed.
