Police Pursuit - Stolen Vehicle

Prineville, Oregon

Location: Prineville area

On 10-19-2011 at around 12:56am, a Prineville Police Officer attempted to make a traffic stop for a traffic violation on North Main street. The vehicle failed to yield and a pursuit ensued.

The pursuit traveled through a residential neighborhood in the northeast area of Prineville. The pursuit ended when the vehicle turned down an alley between NE Loper and NE Ochoco Avenues, where the driver hit a power pole causing the vehicle to be flipped onto its side. The crash did cause a power outage in the area for a short time. Speeds during the pursuit were relatively low and likely did not exceed 40 mph. Following the crash two male subjects fled on foot. The driver, Kenneth Hyde, was located after he broke into a residence at 582 NE Lookout Ave, resulting in residents there contacting the police. The passenger, Trevor Hensley was located a short-time later in the 600 block of NE Ochoco Ave with the assistance of a police K-9. Both Hyde and Hensley were lodged at the Crook County Jail.

Following the pursuit it was learned that the vehicle, a 1997 Hummer, had recently been stolen in the Prineville.

Arrested: Kenneth Wayne Hyde (33) of Spokane Washington:

Charged: Criminal Mischief 1, Criminal Mischief 2, Unauthorized entry into a motor vehicle, Unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, Fail to perform the duties of a driver, Attempt to elude in a vehicle, Attempt to elude on foot, Reckless endangering another person, Reckless driving, Driving while revoked misdemeanor, and Burglary 1.

Bail: (\$80,000)

Arrested: Trevor Kyle Hensley (22) of Spokane Washington:

Charged: with Unauthorized entry into a motor vehicle, Attempted elude on foot, and Violation of a controlled substance (Marijuana).

Bail: (\$10,000) Hensley was released due to overcrowding.

Property damage is estimated to be over \$20,000
