## Vandalism Arrest

**Arrested:** Andrew Michael Zulim, age 19, 131 NW Deer Street, #10, Prineville, OR

**Charged:** Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree x 8 counts, Criminal Mischief in the First Degree, Theft in the Second Degree and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle.

**Bail:** \$55,000.

**Custody Status:** Released due to overcrowding.

**Arrested:** 14 year old, male juvenile of Prineville, OR

**Charged:** Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree x 8 counts, Criminal Mischief in the First Degree, Theft in the Second Degree and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle.

**Bail:** Not applicable.

**Custody Status:** Released to the Crook County Juvenile Department.

On 12-10-2010 at about 12:35am Prineville Police responded to a report of a string of vandalism incidents involving eight local businesses. Many of the businesses had windows broken out in quick succession just prior to the report. Police, carefully examining the multiple crime scenes, were able to recover a key piece of evidence that positively linked Andrew Zulim, through DNA analysis, to at least one of the crime scenes. On 10-14-11 Zulim was interviewed and subsequently arrested for his involvement in crimes at the above mentioned locations, as well as implicating himself in two other, unrelated crimes. Zulim was lodged in the Crook County Jail. A 14 year old male juvenile was identified as an accomplice of Zulim's and was arrested on 10-18-11 for his involvement in the same string of crimes. He was turned over to the Crook County juvenile department.
