



Public Notice

The City of Prineville Public Works Department is scheduled to begin removing a concrete structure,(bridge) on West 2nd St. beginning April 6th if weather permits. During the demolition of this structure, west bound traffic will be maintained along the north curb line, and east bound traffic along the south curb line. During the demolition and subsequent street reconstruction, onstreet parking will not be allowed.

Once the concrete structure is removed, Public Works will begin reconstructing 2nd St. from Deer to Maple. This process will include removing existing asphalt and base material, compacting and installing new base rock to meet the City's Standards and Specifications. Access to residents in this area will be limited during working hours, (7:30 – 3:00) residence access will be reinstated at the close of each day.

Public Works asks that residences located on W 2nd between Deer and Maple understand that during construction there will be substantial equipment noise, anticipated vibrations felt within homes during compaction efforts and again limited access to driveways during working hours.

The reconstruction is anticipated to last approximately 4 weeks, followed by a contracted water main replacement within this same street section. Once street reconstruction and water main replacement is concluded the entire section of W 2nd St. from Deer to Meadow Lakes Dr. will be repaved.
