Issue Summary Report: City of Prineville Council Meeting December 8th, 2009

Topic: Resolution 1120, Oregon Department of Environmental Quality Grant for the development of a Stormwater Master Plan.

Overview:

The City of Prineville was recently successful in obtaining a grant from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to develop a Stormwater Master Plan. This Master Plan will detail the City's drainage features, hydrology, existing stormwater control facilities and management practices. This document will be used to ensure the consistent development of future stormwater handling facilities. It will also identify locations/features within the existing collection system that are most in need of immediate upgrade. This will allow the City of Prineville to develop a priority list of projects related to stormwater collection and treatment. The grant has the following financial considerations...

DEQ Grant	\$70,000.00
City of Prineville Cash Match	\$15,000.00
City of Prineville "In-kind" Match	\$22,500.00
Crooked River Watershed Council "In-kind" Match	\$2,500.00
Crook County School District "In-kind" Match	<u>\$10,000.00</u>
Total	\$120,000.00

These funds have been included in the adopted budget.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends acceptance of the \$70,000.00 grant from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and the authorization of the City Manager to sign such grant agreement documents.

RESOLUTION NO. 1120

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF STATE OF OREGON DEQ GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville applied for a grant through the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to develop a storm water master plan that will detail the City's drainage features, hydrology, existing storm water control facilities, and management practices; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality has approved a \$70,000 grant to the City conditioned on the City contributing \$50,000 toward the development of a storm water master plan with \$35,000 of the City's contribution being an in kind contribution by way of salaries, services, and supplies; and

WHEREAS, City staff believes it is in the best interests of the City to accept the \$70,000 grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the City of Prineville accept the \$70,000 grant from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality known as NPS Grant No. 050-10: City of Prineville Storm Water Pollution Reduction Plan and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the Grant Agreement on behalf of the City of Prineville.
