

**RESOLUTION NO. 1134**

**A RESOLUTION REGARDING A SECOND 2010 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANT GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville Police Department desires to file a second application to receive Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistant Grant (JAG) funds to purchase equipment to be used by City Police Department and the Crook County Sheriff's office; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville Police Department and Crook County Sheriff's office have agreed what equipment should be purchased if the JAG funds are received; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville Police Department believes it is in the best interest of the City to submit an application to receive JAG monies and to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement setting out City's and County's responsibilities regarding the JAG funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Prineville City Council that the City of Prineville Police Department is authorized to submit an application to receive JAG monies and that the Mayor and City Manager are authorized to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and Crook County regarding the purchase of equipment with the JAG funds and the parties' respective responsibilities regarding the equipment to be purchased and responsibilities under the grant.
