

RESOLUTION NO. 1142

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE'S
ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE REVENUE SHARING

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Oregon has provided for the apportionment of certain revenues to the cities of the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, such legislation provides that a city, in order to participate in the sharing of those certain revenues, must express an election to receive such funds, which election must be made prior to June 30 of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville desires to receive a portion of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Prineville does hereby elect to receive its proportionate share of the revenues to be apportioned to the cities by the State of Oregon for the fiscal year 2010-11, and the City Manager of the City of Prineville is directed to take such steps as are necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
