Topic; New Street Sweeper Purchase

Overview;

The Public Works Maintenance Department and the Transportaion Department has solicited quotes for a new street sweeper. All quotes were based on certain City of Prineville specifications. All companies who submitted quotes also brought demonstration machines by the Public Works Compound for review by the staff. Current Senior Staff were consulted in the daily operation, maintenance and or repair of the present sweeper and past sweepers.

Staff feels that maintenance and repair are the two most important items to consider. Therefore a points evaluation was created to evaluate the sweeper companies. Four staff members were asked to evaluate the companies and machines, that outcome is stated in the staff recommendations.

All companies were asked to offer a trade-in value on our current 2002 sweeper.

The City of Prineville received quotes from three companies, Owen Equipment a Elgin dealer for \$152,659.00, less a discount of \$7681.00, and a trade-in allowance of \$61,200.00 net price of \$83,778.00. A quote from Titan Sales Group a Schwarze dealer for \$143,946.00 with a trade-in of \$35000.00 for a net of \$108,946.00. A quote from Clyde West a Tymco dealer for \$152,858.00 minus a trade-in of \$30,000.00 for a net of \$122,858.00.

Staff Recommendation;

Staff requests that the new sweeper quote be awarded to Clyde West dealer of the Tymco model for \$122,858.00. Based on the points evaluation which leads to personnel friendly operation, ease of maintenance, parts availability at local parts stores and overnight freight, mechanic friendly ease of repairs, service and support, and delivery date of new sweeper.

Budgetary Considerations;

The 2007-2008 budget reflectes that the Council has approved an expenditure of \$ 195,000.00 for this equipment. The line item is 10-43100-6250, of which \$30,000.00 was used towards a purchase of used Broce Power Broom.
