

**RESOLUTION NO. 1074**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE SPECIAL  
ASSESSMENT OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES IN THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, in 1975 the State of Oregon instituted the Special Assessment Program giving property owners incentive to preserve the rehabilitation of properties listed in the National Register of Historic Places, and

**WHEREAS**, SB 416 was passed and signed into law by the Governor of the State of Oregon extending the Special Assessment Program through 2010, and

**WHEREAS**, there are three separate properties in the City of Prineville that qualify for this special assessment, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Prineville is committed to preserving our heritage through the preservation of historical buildings,

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PRINEVILLE CITY COUNCIL:**

That the City shall give approval for qualifying property owners to be able to apply for a second term of the special assessment.
