Overview


The Crook County Court contacted the city with information that they owned a strip of land adjacent to Ochoco Creek, west of Deer Street. The walking path is built on this property.

THIS INSTRUMENT DOES NOT ALLOW USE OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS INSTRUMENT IN VIOLATION OF APPLICABLE LAND USE LAWS AND REGULATIONS.
