Dear Meadow Lakes Golf Course,

I am writing to request your support for an event and an organization, both near to my heart. Thousands of wildland firefighters risk their lives every summer to save our wildland resources, and sometimes even our homes, from wildfire. In 1994 fourteen firefighters lost their lives in the Storm King Mountain Fire in Glenwood Springs, Colorado. Nine of those fourteen firefighters were members of the Prineville Hotshots – an initial attack firefighting crew based out of Prineville, Oregon. Following the tragedy, the Prineville community and family members of the 14 came together and began the annual "Prineville Hotshot Memorial Run" to honor those lost. Proceeds from the Memorial Run go to the maintenance of the Prineville Hotshot Memorial and Wildland Firefighter Monument, both located in Ochoco Creek Park in Prineville. Additional proceeds go to support the Wildland Firefighter Foundation.

The Wildland Firefighter Foundation was created in 1994 after the Storm King Fire, when it was apparent that there was a great need that wasn't being met.

The Mission of the Wildland Firefighter Foundation is to honor past, present, and future wildland firefighters by helping maintain and grow the national monument established for those who have lost their lives, operate a financial fund providing assistance to the families of fallen and wildland firefighters and to injured firefighters, and partner with private and interagency organizations to educate the public about wildland fires and promote excellence and safety in firefighting

Running Wildfire, in partnership with the Wildland Firefighter Foundation, works to provide hope and much-needed financial, emotional, and physical support to wildland firefighters and/or their families in times of injury or loss of life. To continue and improve this mission, we need your support. The yearly uniting of families, friends, firefighters, and business organizations at the Prineville Hotshot Memorial Run has impacted many lives locally and nationally.


