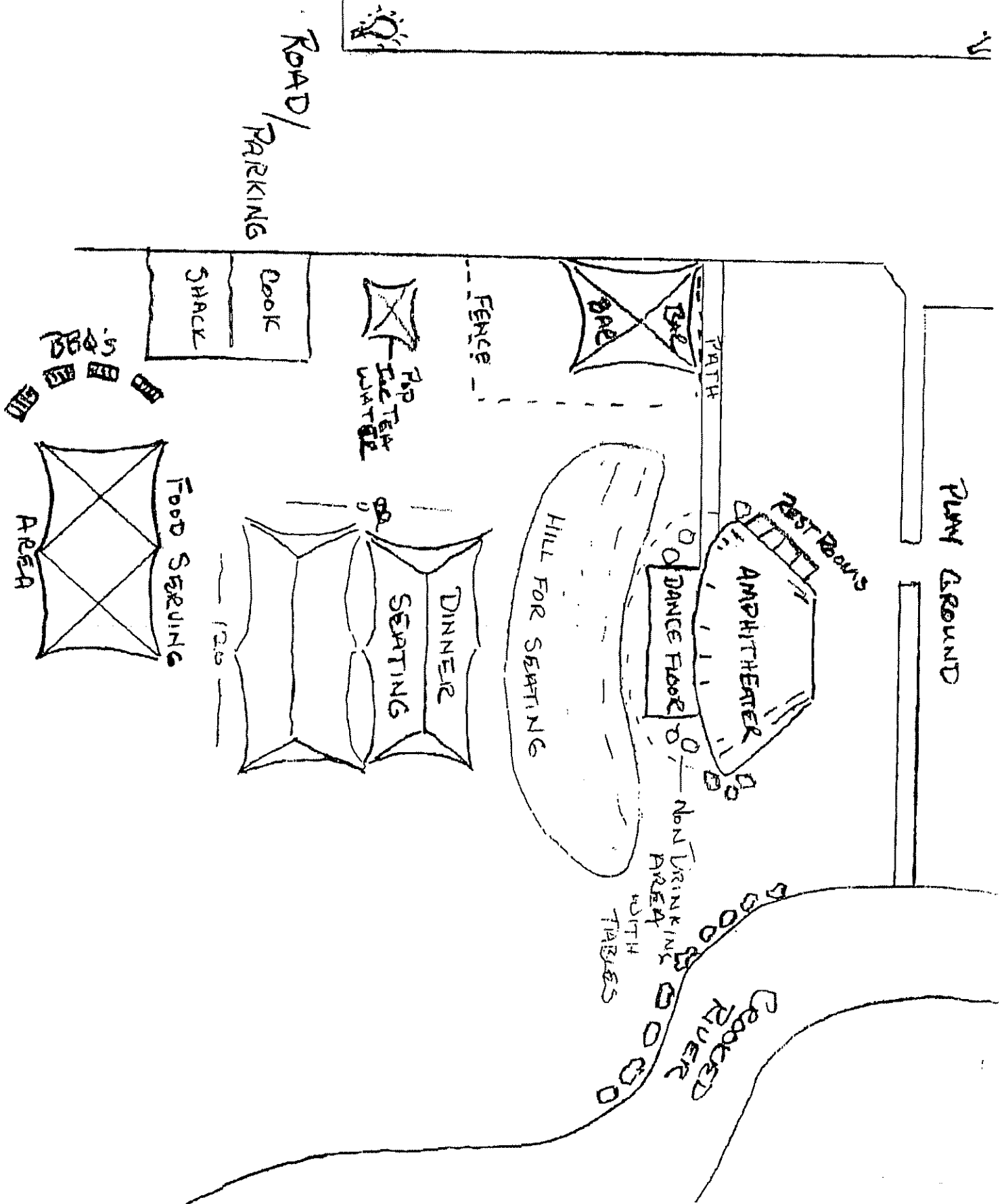

Subject: Control plan for managing minor patrons and adult alcohol consumption at the Les Schwab Banquet

All persons over the age of 21 are given an arm band. Five percent of the 1000 people are under 21 and most leave after dinner. After dinner and the prize giveaway about half of the people leave. Employees working on food revert to alcohol monitors. We also hire event security as alcohol monitors. We have about 30 monitors for 400 people, which will be around the dance floor. The park will be totally closed off and event security will be placed at all gates. No drinks will be allowed outside the designated area.

BARTENDERS

1. All patrons who look under the age of 26 will be required to show an ID. Landmark Catering/The Sandwich Factory policy is to accept only a valid driver's license with a photo or a valid Oregon DMV ID card. Our only exception is a passport that you can read and understand (of course it must have a photo). All Les Schwab employees under 21 will have a name tag that is a different color and stating that they are under 21.
2. The birth date needed to be 21 will be posted at the bar.
3. One person will not be allowed to purchase or receive more than two drinks at a time.
4. The bartenders will not serve alcohol to a visibly intoxicated person.

ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES

1. As all other employees work the event they will be as responsible as the bartenders for controlling underage drinking. If they see any patrons who are under the age of 21 consuming alcohol they are to immediately remove their drink. If an employee thinks that a person might be under 21 and they are drinking alcohol they are to ask to see their ID. If a

patron is visibly intoxicated they are to let the bartender know that they should not be served any more alcohol.

GENERAL RULES

Employees working the event will wear "Landmark Catering" aprons or "Sandwich Factory" shirts, hats, aprons or nametags.

Alcohol and non-alcohol beverages will not be served in the same type of cups. All employees working the event are to know the difference.

The bar will be separated away from the food line, eating area and dance floor. People will have to walk over to the bar to receive a drink. The bar area will be fenced off with only one entrance available to the public. During the event there will be someone posted at the entrance to check ID's. No one will be allowed in that area unless they are over 21.
