Mayor & City Councilors,

On behalf of the City of Prineville Railway, it is my pleasure to inform you that we have been awarded an Oregon Industrial Spur Program grant by the State of Oregon through the Oregon Department of Transportation.

These funds will be used to match *Connect*Oregon III grant funds previously awarded to develop the first phase of a regional bulk transload and intermodal facility located at Prineville Junction.

Total project budget is estimated at \$2,656,010 and the grant award is for \$377,175 that can be applied as a portion of our 20% match obligation.

Our total matching funds obligation of \$531,202 will be met by use of the \$377,175 Industrial Spur Grant with the remaining \$154,031 met through in kind contribution of material already owned by the Railway and services provided by Railway employees.

By executing the agreement the City of Prineville Railway is obligated to:

- 1. Perform the scope of work as outlined in Exhibit B of the agreement
- 2. Do so in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, executive orders and ordinances that are applicable.
- 3. Maintain in a state of good repair all improvements constructed with grant funding for a useful life defined as twenty (20) years

This funding enables the City of Prineville Railway to advance its objective of providing regional access to rail transportation to increase total carloadings and subsequent revenues.
