Re: Downtown Strategic Plan Committee update/coordination report.

This report to the Council flows from discussions at the Downtown Strategic Plan Committee meetings. The Committee Chair Jason Carr has asked staff to provide the Council with an update on the activities of the Downtown Strategic Plan Committee. This memorandum is intended to share with the Council, the Committee direction, connection to the Council goals and provide the Council an opportunity to comment on the Committee activities.

Downtown Strategic Plan Committee Mission Statement

Promote and attract a variety of businesses by creating a vibrant and friendly downtown destination that is aesthetically appealing and accessible.

Downtown Strategic Plan Committee Goals

- 1. Parking Improve Locations.
- 2. Bike lane/sidewalk connections to and in downtown area.
- 3. Aesthetics.
- 4. Plaza/gathering areas.
- 5. Continuity of design.
- 6. Lighting in a cohesive design that is similar throughout downtown such as the lights on the bridge on west side of Prineville.
- 7. Explore incentive and reward programs.
- 8. Partner with the Chamber.
- 9. Survey businesses for needs, wants, strengths and weaknesses

Downtown Strategic Plan Committee Projects

(Important Note: Funding for the Downtown Strategic Plan Committee projects are tied to grant opportunities, with no funding to be provided by the City.)

Short Term (Low Cost)

Project 4	Parking Area Road Striping in City owned parking areas and on 4^{th} Street by pool.
Project 3	New Larger Sign for Public Bathroom Downtown and new bicycle racks.
Project 2	Weed removal around landscape trees in sidewalks on Third Street.
Project 1	Weed removal in sidewalks in Downtown area.

Medium Term (Medium Cost)

Project 5	Pruning and taking care of trees/planting new ones.
Project 6	Coordination/improvements for bicycle paths to and bicycle parking in the Downtown Area.
Project 7	Parking Consultant to Assess Automobile Parking opportunities in Downtown Area.

Long Term (High Cost)

Project 8	Landscaping for City owned Parking Areas.
Project 9	Third Street Road Signage showing Parking Areas.
Project 10	Replace light poles with new, more modern lights that can handle banners and flower baskets.
Project 11	Water fountain/play area in city/county plaza.
Project 12	Bus coordination for certain sectors of Community – Seniors, Veterans, etc.
