

**ORDINANCE NO. 1237**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AN UPDATE TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE WATER SYSTEM MASTER PLAN, AN ANCILLARY DOCUMENT TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, a high quality, well maintained water system is critical for providing adequate and reliable water service to the present and future residents of Prineville; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Prineville Water System Master Plan (WSMP) is an ancillary document to the City's adopted Comprehensive plan consistent with federal requirements, state statutes, and Statewide Planning Goals; and

**WHEREAS**, the WSMP identifies current information on which future operation of the City of Prineville's municipal water system can be based; and

**WHEREAS**, the WSMP was last prepared in 2006, and that the proposed amended WSMP establishes water system design criteria for a 20-year planning period; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Prineville Planning Commission held various work sessions which were open to the public, public comments, were received, and a recommendation of approval of the master plans was forwarded to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was properly noticed and held on March 27, 2018, before the City of Prineville City Council to consider written and oral public testimony, Staff and Planning Commission recommendations, voted to adopt the proposed WSMP as amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Council hereby adopts the WSMP, attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, as an ancillary document to the City's Comprehensive Plan.

Read for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Council held on March 27, 2018, and the City Council finally enacted the foregoing ordinance this \_\_\_\_ day of April, 2018.
