

ORDINANCE NO. 1245

AN ORDINANCE NAMING TWO PRIVATE ROADS WITHIN THE PRINEVILLE/CROOK COUNTY AIRPORT, SW AIRWAY ROAD AND SW FIRELINE ROAD.

The Prineville City Council makes the following findings:

1. The Prineville/Crook County Airport (“Applicant”) in partnership with the property owner Crook County, filed an application with the Crook County Department Addressing Division to name two private roads being developed for the USFS Airbase (Helibase) project. SW Airway Road will begin off of the newly constructed extension of SW Aviation Blvd. and Fireline Road will extend off of SW Airway Road West of the Airbase building as shown in Exhibit ‘A’.

2. As part of the application, the Prineville/Crook County Airport was required to have approval of the City of Prineville because the property is located within Prineville city limits.

3. The Prineville/Crook County Airport is the only property that has access and addressing to the proposed road names. No other property will be effected by these road names.

BASED UPON the above findings, the people of the City of Prineville ordain as follows:

The private roads serving the Prineville/Crook County Airport property are hereby created, as shown on the attached map Exhibit ‘A’.

Presented for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Council held on August 28, 2018, and the City Council finally enacted the foregoing ordinance this ____ day of September, 2018.
