

RESOLUTION NO. 1340

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TO APPLY FOR OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT GRANTS FOR THE NEW OUTDOOR TRACK AT THE BARNES BUTTE RECREATIONAL AREA

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund and state Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville (“City”) desires to participate in the grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation improvements and enhancements for the community; and

WHEREAS, City needs funds to construct recreational facilities at a new regional park and open space complex on a 461.25-acre City Property near Barnes Butte named the Barnes Butte Recreational Area. The City is developing outdoor exercise track from an old historic horse race track. It will have a 12 foot walk and jog path with a rubberized surface and a 6 foot soft surface trail around the outside.

WHEREAS, City Council and staff have identified recreation facility developments at the Barnes Butte Recreational Area as a high priority need in the City and in Crook County; and

WHEREAS, City has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligations related to these grants should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, City will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of these park and recreation facilities should the grant funds be awarded;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Prineville resolves as follows:


1. The Prineville City Council supports and authorizes for the submittal of grant applications to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for development of facilities at the Barnes Butte Recreational Area.

2. The Mayor and City Manager are authorized to sign the grant applications on behalf of the City.
