

**RESOLUTION NO. 1359
CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON**

A RESOLUTION FOR THE PARTIAL DIMINUTION OF WATER RIGHT PERMIT

Whereas, The City of Prineville (“City”) is the holder of Permit G-17236, which authorizes the use of up to 12.48 cfs (and 3682.7 acre-feet) of groundwater for municipal purpose “within City of Prineville Service Boundary;” and

Whereas, City wishes to diminish the authorized rate in Permit G-17236 by 4.46 cfs (and a commensurate volume of 1,322 acre-feet) concurrently with the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) issuing a final order approving the City’s permit application G-18662; and

Whereas, such diminution shall increase the reliability of the City’s water supply; and

Whereas, in order to diminish the authorized rate in Permit G-17236 as set out herein, an affidavit must be signed by a person authorized by City; and

Whereas, City staff believes it is in the best interest of the City to approve and execute the Agreement;

Now, Therefore, based upon the above recitals, the City of Prineville resolves as follows:

1. City’s Manger, Steve Forrester, is authorized and instructed to sign the affidavit for partial diminution of a water right permit.
2. Steve Forrester is also authorized to sign any and all other documents necessary or convenient for partial diminution of water right permit G-17236, as well as any other documents related to Application G-18862 or Permit G-17236.
