

**RESOLUTION NO. 1376
CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF PORTIONS OF THE OLD STRYKER
FIELD FOR THE PURPOSE BUILDING A LARGE-SCALE PLAYGROUND**

Whereas, the City of Prineville (“City”) owns property known as Stryker Park, which is part of the City of Prineville Park System; and

Whereas, The Crook County Parks and Recreation District (CCPRD), through an Intergovernmental Agreement, operates and manages Stryker Park; and

Whereas, CCPRD wishes to establish a large-scale playground within Old Stryker Field and desires approval from the City prior to seeking significant financial contributions; and


Whereas, City believes that the creation of large-scale playground within Old Stryker Field would enhance its City Park system and provide City residents with recreation that will contribute to the City’s health, fitness, and wellbeing; and

Whereas, both City and CCPRD recognize that negotiations would be required to address ongoing operational costs between CCPRD and the City.

Now, Therefore, the City of Prineville resolves as follows:

1. That the City has no objection to the use of the Old Stryker Field for the purpose of building a large-scale playground provided that CCPRD and City have an acceptable Intergovernmental Agreement prior to construction.
