

**RESOLUTION NO. 1389  
CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A GENERAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH PACIFIC  
POWER**

**Whereas**, the City of Prineville (“City”) requires electric service for its water treatment operation at or near 1314 S. Main Street, Prineville, Oregon (“facility”); and


**Whereas**, Pacific Power is able to provide 277/480 volt, three-phase electric service to the City’s facilities;

**Whereas**, the total estimated cost for the extension of electric services to the facility is \$135,452.00. Pursuant to Pacific Power’s filed tariffs and the rules of the Oregon Public Utility Commission, Pacific Power has agreed to invest \$61,198.00 to the project and City shall contribute \$74,254.00 with the City eligible for refunds within sixty (60) months of the date Pacific Power is ready to supply service if additional customers connect to the improvements;

**Whereas**, City and Pacific Power have negotiated a General Service Contract and City Staff believe it is in the best interest of the City to approve and execute the Agreement.

**Now, Therefore**, the City of Prineville resolves that the Agreement attached hereto is hereby approved and that the City Manager is authorized to sign such Agreement on behalf of the City.
