## ORDINANCE NO. 556

AN ORDINANCE to vacate the West Twelve Inches of Main Street, from W. First Street to W. Second Street

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Charter of the City of Prineville, Oregon, a proper, complete and sufficient petition was presented to the Council of the City of Prineville, Oregon for the vacation of the West Twelve Inches of Main Street, from W. First Street to W. Second Street,

AND WHEREAS, said petition has been read and examined by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Prineville, Oregon and the said Council deems it expedient and to the best interests of said City that said petition be granted,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the west twelve inches of Main Street from W. First Street to W. Second Street be and the same is hereby vacated as a public way and street, and all of said twelve inches shall, upon the taking effect of this vacation, become the property of the abutting owners in direct proportion as their respective interests may appear upon the records of the office of the County Clerk of Crook County, Oregon, at the time this ordinance shall take effect.
