

ORDINANCE NO. 555

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 6 of Ordinance No. 424, entitled "An ordinance relating to traffic and regulating the use of public streets and highways of the City of Prineville, providing for the installation, regulation and control of the use of parking meters and parking meter zones; defining parking meter zones; authorizing a method of payment for parking meters and the installation thereof exclusively from the receipts obtained from their operation; providing for enforcement and penalty for violation thereof and providing that invalidity of part shall not affect the validity of remainder."

*The People of the City of Prineville do Ordain as follows:*

Section 1/. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 424 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 6: Citation Tags: The Marshal is hereby authorized and directed to supply police officers with citation tags for the purpose of giving notice to persons violating any provisions of this ordinance. Such notice may be given by delivering such tags to the violator or by affixing it to the vehicle by means of which the violation occurred. Such citation tag shall direct the violator to appear and to present such tag at a designated place on or before a date and hour specified thereon. Nothing in this section shall be construed to abridge the power of a police officer to arrest any violator and take him into custody.

Procedure for tagging vehicles: Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked or stopped in violation of any of the restrictions imposed by this ordinance, the officer finding such vehicle shall take its registration number and may take any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a notice in writing on a form provided by the City for the driver to answer to the charge against him within three (3) days and at the time and place specified in the notice. The officer shall deliver copies of such notice to the Municipal Judge.

Procedure for Impoundment of Vehicles: Any police officer may impound any motor vehicle parked at a place where parking is prohibited by this ordinance, or which has been parked for more than one hour in excess of the time allowed for parking in any place, or which has been involved in any violation of this ordinance, for which citation tag has been issued and not presented as required herein. Any person desiring to redeem such impounded vehicle shall first pay such fine or fines as may be assessed by the Judge of the Municipal Court for the violation for which such motor vehicle was impounded, and in addition shall pay the towing and storage fee incurred to impound such vehicle.
