

ORDINANCE NO. 693

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 of ORDINANCE NO. 630 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE COST OF REPLACING AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE."

The People of the City of Prineville ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 630, passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor April 30, 1969, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That there is hereby established a financial reserve or special fund for the purpose of financing the cost of replacing the ambulance equipment of the City of Prineville, which fund may be increased by the addition of an amount not to exceed \$3,000 per year for a period not to exceed ten (10) years, the total sum of said fund not to exceed \$30,000. The amount to be added to said fund each year shall be determined by the City Council at the time the annual City Budget is prepared.
