AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CURBING AND PAVING OF NORTH FAIRMONT STREET RETWEEN NORTH NIMTH STREET AND NORTH TENTH STREET, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TO CAUSE THE COMSTRUCTION OF SAID PROJECT; SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROTESTS AGAINST SAID IMPROVEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE SERVING OF THE OWNERS OF ADJACENT PROPERTY WITH NOTICE OF SAID HEARING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of Princyille, Oregon to cause the grading, paying, curbing and improvement of the following described street within the following described area, to wit:

Fairmont Street from the north right of way or North Minth Street to the south right of way line of Morth Tenth Street, beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 2 of Steve W. Yancy Addition thence north 240 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 2; thence east 252 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 7, Block 11; thence south 240 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 12, Block 11, thence west 252 feet to the point of beginning.

In accordance with adopted and identified plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Administrator, City Hall, Prineville, Oregon, to which plans and specifications reference is hereby made for details, and estimated costs thereof, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefitted by such improvement its preportionate share of the cost of said improvement as provided by ORS 223.389,

Section 2. The City Council will meet in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, on the 28th day of August, 1973, at 8 P.M., at which time and place the owners of said adjacent property are hereby called upon to appear before said Council and show cause, if any, why said improvements should not be constructed and why said property should not be assessed for the construction thereof.

Section 3. The City Recorder-Treasurer is hereby directed to serve notice hereof on the property owners of aforesaid, by posting five (5) copies of this Ordinance in five (5) public, conspicuous places in said City for a period of ten (10) days prior to said hearing, and by notifying them by certified mail of said meeting at least ten (10) days in advance thereof.

Now Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the City Council, and approval by the Mayor.
