ORDINANCE NO. 850

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 568; ALLOWING FOR SERVING OF A NUISANCE ABATEMENT NOTICE IN PERSON BY A PEACE OFFICER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 16 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 16. Abatement Notice

- (2) At the time of posting, either:
 - (a) The City Recorder or person authorized by the Chief of Police shall cause a copy of such notice to be forwarded by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid to the owner or person in charge of the property at the last known address of such owner or other person, or
 - (b) A Peace Officer designated by the Chief of Police shall cause a copy of such notice to be delivered to the owner or person in charge of the property. Such delivery shall be made in person, and both copy delivered and copy retained shall bear time and date of delivery and signature of officer performing same.
- 2. All other sections of Ordinance No. 568 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Inasmuch as it is necessary for health, safety and welfare of the City of Prineville that this ordinance go into effect immediately after its passage, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
