

ORDINANCE NO. 854

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE 1981-82 TAX YEAR

WHEREAS, the Common Council has prepared a budget for the City of Prineville for the fiscal year 1981-82 commencing July 1, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the budget was approved by the Budget Committee on March 19, 1981, and adopted by the Common Council on June 23, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council must levy the taxes provided for in the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Prineville does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City of Prineville hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted on June 23, 1981, and subsequently revised on July 30, 1981, General Fund \$183,168 (tax base \$72,668 and levy outside 6% \$110,500), Street Improvement Fund (one year special levy) \$95,000, and Bonded Indebtedness within the Fire Hall Bonded Debt Fund \$5,420, in the aggregate amount of \$283,588, and these taxes are hereby levied and assessed prorata upon all taxable property within the City of Prineville as of 1:00 a.m., January 1, 1981. A copy of the adopted budget is on file to support Resolution No. 588, adopting budget and making appropriations, and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Recorder shall certify to the County Assessor of Crook County, Oregon, the tax levy made by this ordinance and shall file two true copies of the budget as finally adopted with the County Assessor of Crook County, Oregon.

Section 3. The Common Council finds and declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary for the health, safety and peace of the residents of the City of Prineville and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




