ORDINANCE NO. 872

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DOWNTOWN PARKING AREA AND RESTRICTING PARKING WITHIN THE AREA; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Prineville, Oregon, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The following definitions shall apply in this Ordinance:

Employee -- Anyone being engaged for wages, credit, or other remuneration including employers, agents, salesmen, representatives, or volunteer for a public or private enterprise when said enterprise is located within the City of Prineville, Oregon.

Downtown Parking Area -- In Prineville, Oregon, the area contained within the following: Beginning at the Northwest corner of West 4th Street and North Claypool Street, then South to the Northwest corner of West 3rd Street and Claypool Streets, then West to the Northeast corner of West 3rd Street and North Deer Street, then South to the Southeast corner of West 3rd Street and North Deer Street, thence East to the Southwest corner of West 3rd Street and North Claypool Street, then South to the Southwest corner of West 2nd Street and North Claypool Street, then East to the Southeast corner of East 2nd Street and North Court Street, thence North to the Southeast corner of North Court Street and East 3rd Street, thence East to a point on East 3rd Street directly South of the East right of way line of North Dunham Street, then North to the Northeast corner of North Dunham and East 3rd Streets, then West to the Northeast corner of North Court and East 3rd Streets, then North to the Northwest corner of the portion of East 4th Street that was vacated between North Court and North Dunham, then West to the Northwest corner of the intersection of North Claypool Street and West 4th Street, the point of beginning.

Vehicle Owned -- Any vehicle registered to, operated, or controlled by a person.

Section 2.

- (a) Except as provided in Subsection (b), (c) or (d), no person shall, while at his or her place of employment, when said place of employment is located within the Downtown Parking Area, cause, allow, suffer or permit any motor vehicle owned by that person to be parked in any one or more parking spaces upon the public streets within the downtown parking area between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on any day.
- (b) This Section shall not apply on Sundays or State holidays.
- (c) Vehicles owned by employees shall be allowed to load or unload their vehicle for a maximum period of 30 minutes in the downtown parking area.
- (d) This Section shall not apply to a vehicle owned by an employee but being operated by someone other than the employee.

Section 3. No employee shall cause a vehicle owned by that person to be parked on a public street within the Downtown Parking Area except within an individually marked parking space.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00.

Section 5. It being deemed by the City Council of the City of Prineville that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the City Council and Mayor.


