ORDINANCE NO. 918

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL IN ORDER TO INSURE A TIMELY RESPONSE; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 843 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

WHEREAS, from time to time emergency situations arise which require the timely physical presence of certain City of Prineville employees; and

WHEREAS, in an attempt to help insure the timely presence of these employees,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. "Emergency response personnel" shall be defined as police officers, paid firemen and paid ambulance response personnel, and
- 2. All "emergency response personnel" hereafter employed by the City of Prineville shall be required to reside in close enough proximity to the City of Prineville so as to insure a response time of twenty (20) minutes when driving at normal rates of speed under normal conditions, and
- 3. Said residency shall be established within six (6) months from the date of hire, and
 - 5. Ordinance no. 843 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
