AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRIVING ACROSS PRIVATE PROPERTY TO AVOID A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE AND SETTING A PENALTY

The people of the City of Prineville ordain as follows:

1. Definitions:

- (a) <u>Traffic control device</u>: any sign, signal, marking or device placed or erected for the purpose of guiding, directing, warning or regulating traffic.
- 2. A person commits the offense of operator avoiding a traffic control device if an operator of a vehicle crosses private property to avoid a traffic control device.
- 3. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$100.00.
