ORDINANCE NO. 947

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, PAVING, CURBING AND IMPROVEMENT OF PORTIONS OF LOOKOUT AVENUE, LOPER AVENUE, AND DEL RIO AVENUE; DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TO CAUSE THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID PROJECT; SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROTEST AGAINST SAID IMPROVEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SERVING OF THE OWNERS OF ADJACENT PROPERTY WITH NOTICE OF SAID HEARING; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 945; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON, ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of Prineville, Oregon, to cause the grading, paving, curbing, and improvement of the following described streets within the following described area, to-wit:

Del Rio Avenue between Ochoco Avenue and Loper AVenue; Lookout Avenue between Del Rio Avenue and the intersection with Del Norte Avenue; and Loper Avenue between Del Rio Avenue and the alley on the northwest side of Block 5 of Loma Vista Subdivision

in accordance with adopted and identified plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Administrator, City Hall, Prineville, Oregon (a copy of which is attached hereto), and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvements its proportionate share of the costs of said improvement as provided by ORS 223.380.

Section 2. The City Council will meet in the City Council chambers of Prineville City Hall, on the 25th day of September, 1990, at 7:00 p.m., at which time and place the owners of said adjacent properties are hereby called upon to appear before said Council and show cause, if any, why said improvements should not be constructed, and why said property should not be assessed for the construction thereof.

Section 3. The City Recorder/Administrator is hereby directed to serve notice hereof on the property owners of the above described properties by mailing to each property owner by certified mail of said meeting at least ten (10) days in advance thereof.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 945 dated August 29, 1990, is hereby repealed.

 $\frac{\text{Section 5}}{\text{ordinance}}$. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passing by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
