

**AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE WEST FIVE (5) FEET OF
DEL RIO AVENUE BETWEEN LOPER AVENUE AND OCHOCO AVENUE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of ORS Chapter 271, the Council of the City of Prineville, through the City of Prineville Planning Commission by petition of the City of Prineville, has initiated vacation proceedings for that area referred to above, and more specifically described herein below; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville Planning Commission held a public review on the vacation on October 15, 1991, and unanimously recommended approval of the street vacation; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the City of Prineville after giving notice as required by ORS Chapter 271, and said Council deems that it is in the best interests of the City of Prineville and the area property owners that said vacation be granted;


NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the West five (5) feet of Del Rio Avenue located north of Ochoco Avenue and South of Loper Avenue, in Township 14 South, Range 16 East of the Willamette Meridian in Section 32DB, is hereby vacated.


2. That portion of Del Rio Avenue that is vacated by this Ordinance shall, upon this vacation taking effect, become the property of the owners of the adjacent parcels identified as Lots 1 through 6 of Block 7, and Lot 9 of Block 4 of Loma Vista Subdivision, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk for Crook County, Oregon.
