AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF WATER IN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Between April 15 and October 15 of each year users of City of Prineville water for irrigation shall comply with the following restrictions:

A. Persons with even house numbers shall irrigate only on even numbered days of the month and persons with odd house numbers shall irrigate only on odd numbered days of the month.

B. Irrigation shall be prohibited between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

C. Irrigation shall NOT be allowed on the 31st day of a month for either even or odd house numbers.

D. Irrigation shall be defined as watering trees, lawns, soil, bushes, flowers, plants or other vegetation by any means, including but not limited to: hand held hoses, sprinklers or ditches.

2. The City Manager may restrict all use of City water for irrigation purposes upon any emergency situation or for essential purposes.

3. Violators of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$500 for each violation.

4. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not effect the validity of any part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

5. It being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the City Of Prineville that this Ordinance go into effect immediately after its passage, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.
