ORDINANCE NO. 1052

AN ORDINANCE SELLING REAL PROPERTY IN BALDWIN ROAD INDUSTRIAL PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

<u>Recitals</u>

A. Calvin D. Craig and Jeanette A. Craig, husband and wife, have offered to purchase Lot 18 of Baldwin Road Industrial Park from the City of Prineville.

B. As required by state statute, on October 21, 1997, the City published notice of the proposed sale in the Central Oregonian and conducted a public hearing on October 28, 1997.

C. The nature of the proposed sale and the general terms thereof including evidence of the market price was presented at such hearing.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 1. The City of Prineville shall sell to Calvin D. Craig and Jeanette A. Craig, real property in Crook County, Oregon described as: Lot 18 of Baldwin Road Industrial Park according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk for Crook County, Oregon.

2. The purchase price for this property shall be \$55,100 plus purchaser shall pay one-half of the closing costs.

3. The other terms of the sale are included in a Sale Agreement and Receipt for Earnest Money executed by Calvin D. Craig and Jeanette A. Craig on September 30, 1997.
