## ORDINANCE NO. 1103

An Ordinance amending Chapter 51 Section 104 (B)(1) and amending Chapter 52 Section 102(A)(1) and (2) of the code of Prineville.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Chapter 51 of the Code of Prineville, Section 51.104 (B)(1) is hereby repealed and the following language is substituted in its place:

After an account becomes delinquent, a turn-off notice will be sent to the billing address. The notice shall state a date not less than ten days from the date of the notice on which water service to the premises will be turned off if the delinquency amount is not paid in full prior thereto. On or after the turn-off date, if the delinquent amount has not been paid in full, the Superintendent may disconnect the service of the water system to the premises. Water services will be withheld until all delinquent amounts owing for sewer services supplied to the premises have been paid in full, together with the reconnection fee for the water services. The amount of the reconnection fee for the water service is specified in the City's water system ordinances incorporated herein by reference;

2. Chapter 52 of the Code of Prineville, Section 52.102 (A)(1) is hereby repealed and the following language is substituted in its place:

(1) Delinquent Notice. A reminder of account delinquency will be sent to each delinquent account after the account becomes delinquent. If the property is rented, the reminder will be sent to the premises and to the owner of record.

3. Chapter 52 of the Code of Prineville, Section 52.102 (A)(2) is hereby repealed and the following language is substituted in its place:

(2) Turn-off Notice. After an account becomes delinquent, a turn-off notice will be sent to the customer. The notice shall state a date not less than ten days from the date of the notice on which water will be turned off if the delinquent account is not paid in full prior thereto. If the property is rented, the property owner may request notice as listed in Division (A)(1) of this Section.
