ORDINANCE NO. 1107

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING REAL PROPERTY TO CROOK COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT

RECITALS:

- A. The City owns real property described as Lots 8 and 9 in Conestoga Park, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the county clerk for Crook County, Oregon.
- B. The above properties were flooded in 1998 and because of the flooding the City acquired the properties using federal funds received through the Hazard Mitigation Grant program.
- C. The City has no current use for the properties and desires to transfer the property to Crook County Parks and Recreation District so they can use the property for open space, parks, or natural areas for perpetual public use.

BASED UPON THE above recitals, the people of the City of Prineville ordain as follows:

- 1. The City of Prineville shall transfer to Crook County Parks and Recreation District the real property described in Recital 1 above. The deed transferring such property shall include a restriction that limits the uses of the property to open space, parks, or natural areas for perpetual public use. The deed shall also contain a provision for the reversion of the property to the City of Prineville if the property is not used in conformance with the restrictions.
 - 2. The Mayor and City Manager are authorized to sign the deed to transfer the property.
