A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND SUPPORTING THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE'S APPLICATION FOR A 2011 TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FROM OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO UPDATE THE CITY'S TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville is applying for a 2011 Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation to update the city's Transportation Systems Plan (TSP); and


WHEREAS, the TGM Grant will allow the City of Prineville to amend the current 2005 TSP to more accurately reflect the city's existing and future transportation system capacity; to identify and prioritize projects that more closely reflect the goals and needs of the community; and to establish project costs that are up to date; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Prineville City Council to ensure a sustainable and economically viable transportation system through responsible long-range transportation system planning; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville has the capacity to meet the required eleven percent (11%) project match through the use of in-kind staff resources;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE RESOLVES THAT THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY APPROVE AND SUPPORT THE APPLICATION FOR A 2011 TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO UPDATE THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS PLAN.
