## A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, CROOK COUNTY AND THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE HIGHWAY 126 REFINEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, well-planned infrastructure is a goal of the Prineville City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City's transportation system is a key component of the City's infrastructure necessary to support economic development, and

WHEREAS, the Highway 126 Corridor, in particular, is critical for promoting development within the City's primary industrial areas, and

WHEREAS, the first step toward addressing issues related to growth-related transportation along this corridor is the creation of the Highway 126 Refinement Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS Chapter 190, the parties have authority to enter into an intergovernmental agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the City of Prineville shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Crook County and the State of Oregon for the development of the Highway 126 Refinement Plan and the Mayor and City Manager are authorized and instructed to sign such agreement.
