A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING A CONTRACT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

The City Council of Prineville, Oregon sitting as the City of Prineville Public Contract Review Board find as follows:

1. That the purchase by the City of Prineville of a TYMCO model 600 street sweeper from Environmental Pollution Control, Inc. will result in substantial cost saving to the City of Prineville.

2. That the lack of bids for the purchase of the street sweeper will not result in favoritism or substantially diminish competition in awarding the contract.

3. That under the Attorney General's model public contract rules manual requirement contract are exempt when another public contracting agency has contracted with the supplier and when a formal inter-agency agreement exists between the two public agencies.

4. That the public contract rules of the City of Prineville allow an exemption for contracts exempted by state law.

Based upon the above findings, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the contract with Environmental Pollution Control for the purchase of a TYMCO model 600 street sweeper is exempt from competitive bidding.
