A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON, ADOPTING A POLICY OF NON-DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF HANDICAPPED STATUS.

WHEREAS, Section 51.55 of the Federal Revenue Sharing Regulations prohibits discrimination in employment against qualified individuals because of their handicapped status, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to inform the public, city employees and job applicants that the City of Prineville does not discriminate on the basis of handicap status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Prineville that it is the policy of the City of Prineville that it does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administrator is designated as the program coordinator to implement this handicap nondiscrimination policy. He is directed to give adequate notice of the policy as required by the applicable regulations.
