

RESOLUTION NO. 615

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING OR REJECTING A NEW TAX BASE FOR THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$315,712; CALLING FOR A BALLOT FOR SAID ELECTION TO BE PREPARED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS; SETTING THE DATE AND PLACE FOR SAID ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, in at least three of the past four fiscal years the City of Prineville has submitted to the voters proposed tax levies in excess of its present tax base and received voter approval and levied taxes outside its present tax base,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Prineville resolve as follows:

Section 1. That an election to provide for a vote on a new tax base for the City of Prineville in the amount of \$315,712 be held on May 15, 1984. Said new tax base would be effective in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1984.

Section 2. That a ballot and ballot measure on said election shall be prepared and presented to the Crook County Clerk in accordance with applicable State laws.

Section 3. That said election be held on Tuesday, May 15, 1984, in Prineville, Crook County, Oregon.


Section 4. That the City Recorder shall cause to be published, one or more times, a notice of election in full with the ballot title, within the time period established by statute, in the Central Oregonian, the official newspaper of the City. The first publication of said notice shall be not less than ten (10) days prior to said election. Written notice of the proposed new tax base shall be posted in three public places: (1) Bulletin Board, City Hall; (2) Bulletin Board, United States Post Office, Prineville, Oregon, and (3) Bulletin Board, Crook County Courthouse, Prineville, Oregon. The City Recorder shall make such arrangements with the Crook County Clerk of Court as are necessary for the conduct of this election.
