

RESOLUTION NO. 488

A RESOLUTION STATING THE BUDGETARY INTENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE RELATIVE TO THE PRINEVILLE BURGLARY INVESTIGATION AND PREVENTION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville, Oregon, in the interests of combating the rising rate of burglary within the City by improving investigative efforts and undertaking a program of community education in burglary prevention, did apply to the Oregon Law Enforcement Council (OLEC) through the Central Oregon Law Enforcement Planning Agency for a grant to undertake such a project and did receive a grant for that purpose;

WHEREAS, a question has arisen with respect to said grant as to whether the federal funds allocated by the OLEC for this project were utilized to supplant local funds previously set aside for the grant purposes;

WHEREAS, the definition provided to the City of Prineville by OLEC representatives of "supplanting" states that "supplanting is the use of federal funds to support an ongoing activity formerly supported by general local funds";

WHEREAS, due to certain ambiguities in the City of Prineville's fiscal year 1975-76 Budget document with respect to this matter, representatives of the OLEC have requested a clarification of the City Council's budget intent with respect to this program and the issue of supplanting in particular;

THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The intent of the City Council of the City of Prineville in the preparation of the City's FY 1975-76 Budget was not to use federal funds to support an ongoing activity formerly supported by local general funds, but rather to use those federal funds to establish and support a new program activity within the City Police Department developed to address in a very specific and concentrated manner the objective of reducing the incidence of crimes of burglary within the City of Prineville through improved and intensified investigative efforts and the development of an active program of community education in burglary prevention.
