

RESOLUTION NO. 349

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize certain budget transfers in order to comply with the provisions of the Local Budget Law,

AND WHEREAS, transfers to close the City Budget for the fiscal year July 1, 1967 through June 30, 1968 have been prepared by Dietrich, Bye, Griffin and Youel, the City's auditors,

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary to make budget transfers to cover additional payroll expense and office equipment expense in the Recorder-Treasurer's office,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the following transfers be made in the 1968-69 Budget:

To Recorder-Treasurer, Personal Services:

City Administrator \$3,200.

Extra Office Help 1,000.
