

Public Notice, Paving Project

The City of Prineville will begin their annual paving project the week of July 9. The project will begin on Fairview St. Tri-County Paving of Redmond Oregon was the successful bidder and will be grinding the existing asphalt on Fairview from NE 4th to SE 5th and also SE 2nd from Fairview to Idlewood on July 9th and 10th. Fairview access will be limited to only residences that face Fairview on these days. Beginning July 23rd and 24th Fairview and SE 2nd will be repaved with the Fairview paving extending south to Lynn Blvd.

On July 17 and 18 the contractor will be grinding out start points on N Main beginning at Peters Rd. extending north to almost NW Gerke Rd. During this event traffic control will be in place and flaggers will be directing traffic through the work zones. On July 19 and 20 they will be placing a new 2 inches of asphalt. During this procedure they will be utilizing a pilot car to lead traffic through the project, all intersecting roads must wait until the pilot car passes before entering N Main/McKay.

Please allow yourself extra time to arrive at your destination during this week of paving.

On July 25th we will move to NE Stearns Dr. and repave Stearns from Cattleman to NE 3rd St. Residences of Chrystal Springs neighborhood are asked to limit the trips to and from home on the 25th. It is expected to take approx. a half day to pave Stearns. The afternoon of July 25th we will repave NE Slayton Ct. and NE Baldwin Ct and NE Williamson Dr. Again residences are asked to minimize the vehicle trips in this area. Access to the Carriage House assisted living will be maintained but limited.
