Request for designation as the non-federal representative to consult

with the

National Marine Fisheries Service as necessary to comply with Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act.

On November 26, 2018, the Ochoco Irrigation District (District) submitted a request to be designated as the non-federal representative to conduct information consultation with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service as necessary to comply with section 7 of the Endangered Species Act. On February 6, 2019, the Commission designated the District as the non-federal representative for carrying out informal consultation pursuant to section 7 of the Endangered Species Act.

In its November 26, 2018, submittal the District failed to include in its request to be designated as the non-federal representative to conduct informal consultation with the National Marine Fisheries Service as necessary to comply with section 7 of the Endangered Species Act. Therefore, the District is requesting the Commission designate the District to conduct informal consultation with the National Marine Fisheries Service in pursuit of section 7 of the Endangered Species Act.
